


Finger joint poplar is now the default jamb material for sizes $3-\frac{1}{2}$ " up to $6-\frac{7}{8}$ "

For jamb widths outside of these common widths, we offered solid poplar material with an upcharge. We have now expanded the finger joint poplar jamb material offering to all wall depth configurations from 3-½" all the way up to 6-%". This expanded offering now gives our customers a high-quality finger joint poplar jamb material option at a price advantage over solid poplar across these jamb widths. Of course, you will still be able to upgrade any jamb width option to solid poplar if desired.

In TruQuote, finger joint poplar is now the default jamb material selection for all jamb widths from 3 - ½" up to 6 - 7%" for interior MDF doors. You can easily and always upgrade to solid poplar by selecting that option in the jamb material drop down. Please note, for the next 30 days, there will be a pop-up warning when selecting these jamb widths in TruQuote, to notify users about this material default change.
