


Material Construction

TruStile pioneered the use of medium density fiberboard (MDF) as a preferred material for stile and rail painted door applications. Each MDF door has been engineered for maximum stability and durability. They won't shrink, crack, expand or warp when exposed to environmental conditions.

TruStile MDF doors come standard with The Wedge[®], our field-proven hardwood edge system. Designed to stand up to daily use, The Wedge provides superior rigidity, stability and screw-holding power.

Not Every Door is Created Equal

TruStile builds its MDF doors using traditional stile & rail construction, a method usually reserved for wood doors. Unlike low-grade options, our premium MDF doors are solid and never filled with cheap core materials. They deliver a heavy swing weight that you can feel.

MDF doors are ideal for painted applications and make an affordable alternative to wood doors. The super-refined MDF that TruStile uses provides a smoother painting surface than pine, poplar or lower-grade MDF alternatives.
