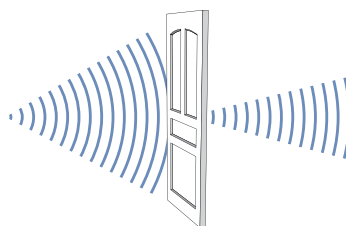
Recycled Content

TruStile MDF doors feature solid door construction. The added density of our super-refined MDF creates a door that on average is 25-50% heavier than similar doors and produces a noticeable swing weight that conveys a feeling of quality.



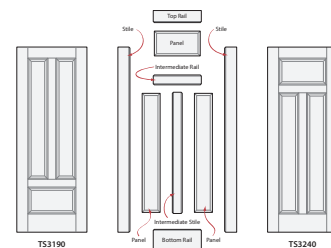
Better Acoustical Properties

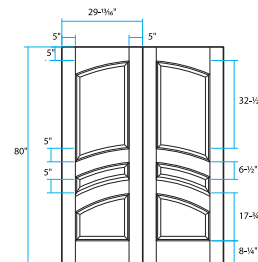
Meets CARB Requirements

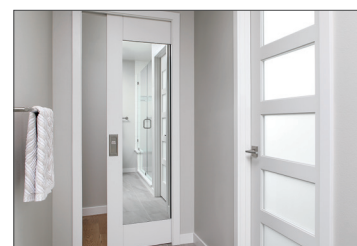
Architectural Detail
